FAIRFIELD COUNTY CHORALE PRESENTS: ETERNAL LIGHT

Norwalk, CT — The Fairfield County Chorale proudly presents *Eternal Light*, an illuminating evening of transcendent choral works exploring themes of peace, divinity, and spiritual awe. This inspiring program brings together masterworks by Lili Boulanger, Nadia Boulanger, John Rutter, Pēteris Vasks, and Leonard Bernstein, performed by the Fairfield County Chorale and orchestra under the direction of Maestro David Rosenmeyer.

The program opens with Lili Boulanger's *Psalm 24: La terre appartient à l'Éternel*, a bold and stirring proclamation of faith. One of the first great female composers of sacred music, Boulanger's intensity and conviction shine through every note.

We continue with the luminous beauty of Nadia Boulanger's *Lux Aeterna*, a shimmering invocation of eternal light and hope.

The energy expands in John Rutter's jubilant *Gloria*, whose driving rhythms and radiant harmonies create an exhilarating expression of praise.

A contemplative plea for peace follows in Pēteris Vasks' *Da Pacem Domine*, a deeply moving work that calls for both inner and global harmony.

The evening culminates in Leonard Bernstein's *Chichester Psalms*—a vibrant, theatrical, and deeply heartfelt setting of Hebrew texts that blends rhythmic vitality, lyrical beauty, and unmistakable dramatic flair.

Eternal Light promises an inspiring experience of musical illumination—an evening where choral artistry transcends time and speaks directly to the spirit.

The Norwalk Concert Hall, renowned for its exceptional acoustics and elegant ambiance, serves as the perfect venue for this extraordinary evening. Located at 125 East Avenue, Norwalk, CT, the hall offers a comfortable and immersive concert experience for all music enthusiasts.
